## Leaders in the clubhouse



### Bev Brines

Long Beach, Calif.

A retired Air Force officer, nurse and teacher, Brines knows how to motivate. In 1991, she put those skills to work by founding, with American Golf Corp., the Long Beach Junior Golf Association. The program marches young golfers (700 this year, with a waiting list) through everything from basic instruction to on-course etiquette. Discipline is stressed: There's a dress code of bright red shirts and white caps and close scrutiny of school report cards. "Just the threat of the loss of golf privileges is usually incentive enough to keep grades up," says Brines.
